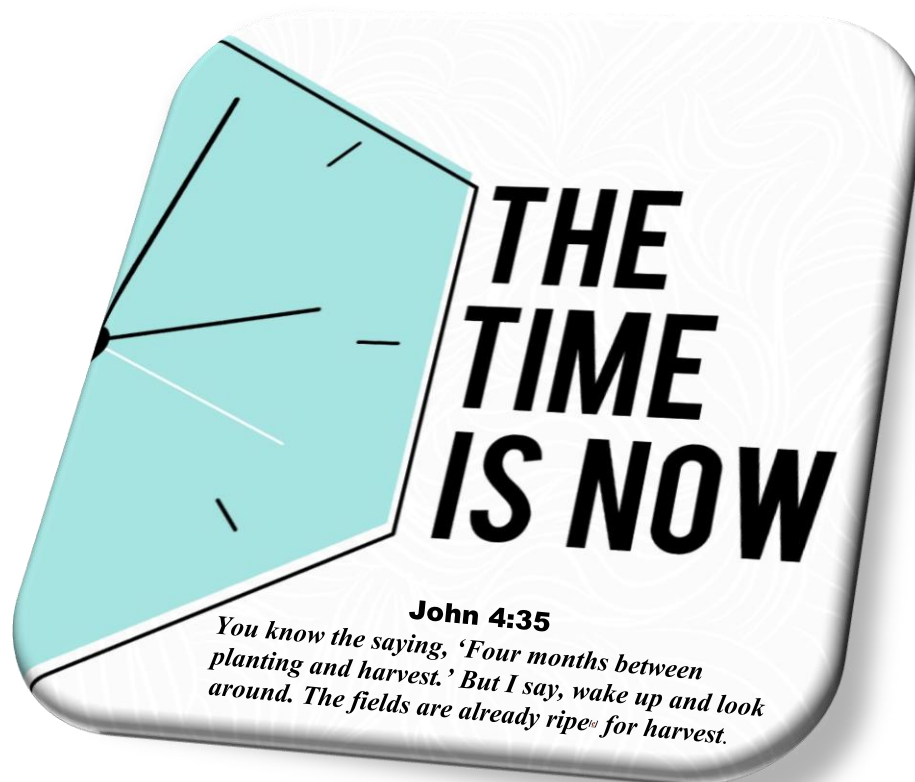

Cart Usage: We will have a golf cart for those who have difficulty with walking and moving your luggage

Keys: We will be distributing room keys during check-in

Lodging/Bedding/Linens: Once we have registration information, we will be rooming people in the dorm buildings. The room assignments will be based on needs such as wheelchair accessibility and singles/doubles. We will be distributing the linens (pillow cases, sheets, blankets, towels, and washcloths) during check in and will be collecting them after the convention on the individual floors.
